



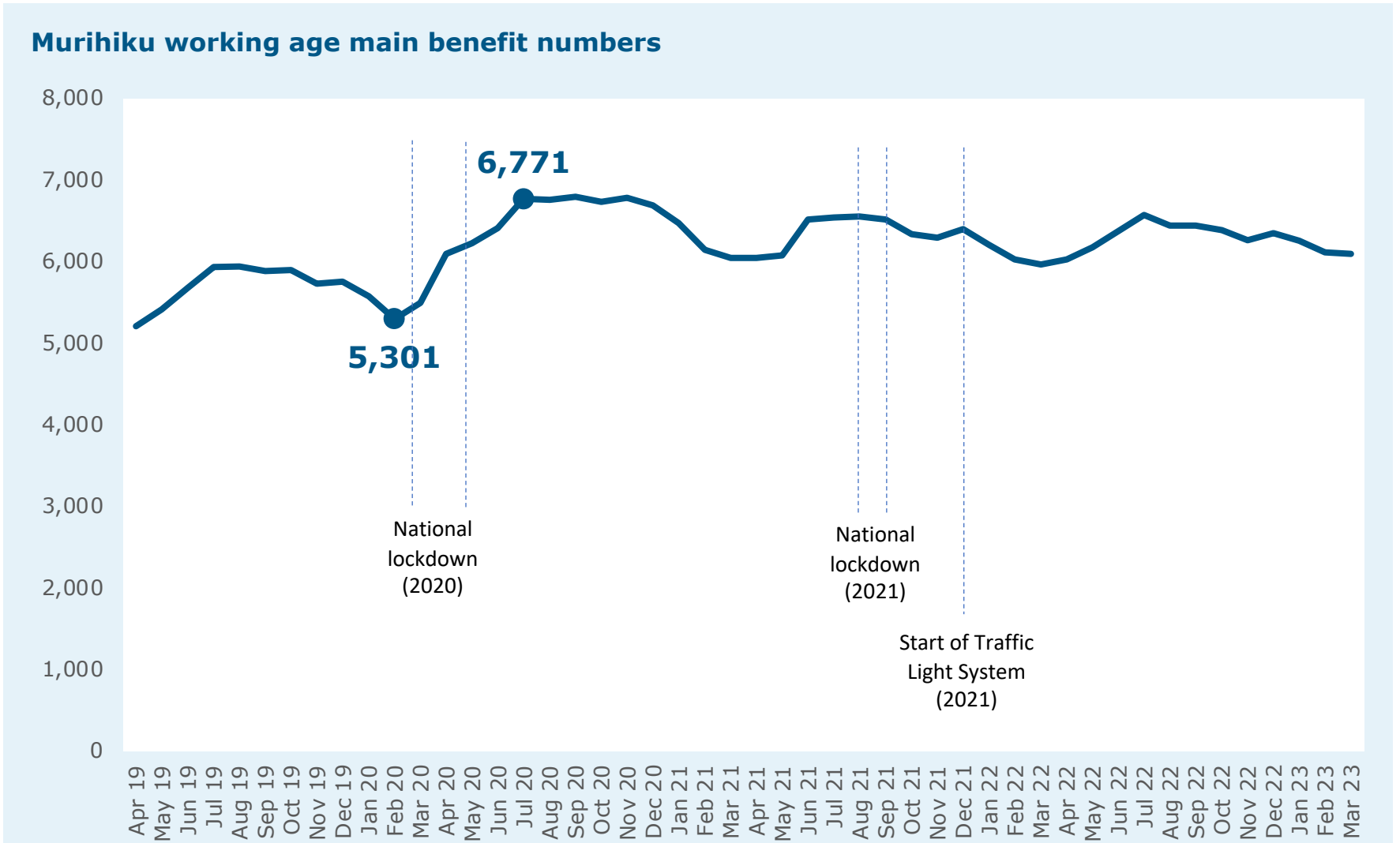

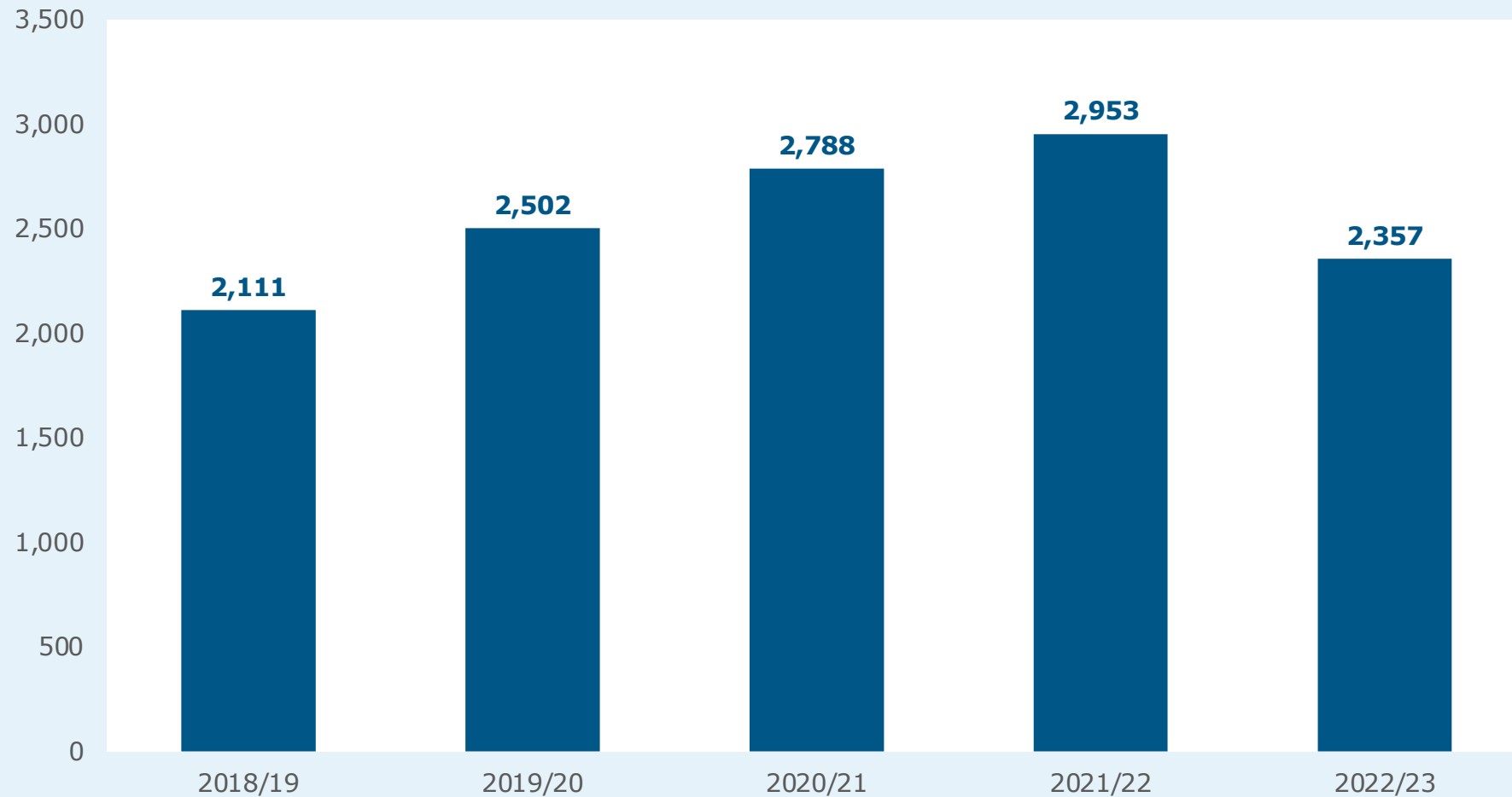
More people came onto a benefit during the pandemic

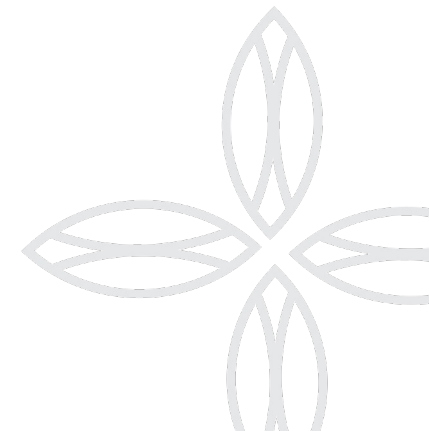

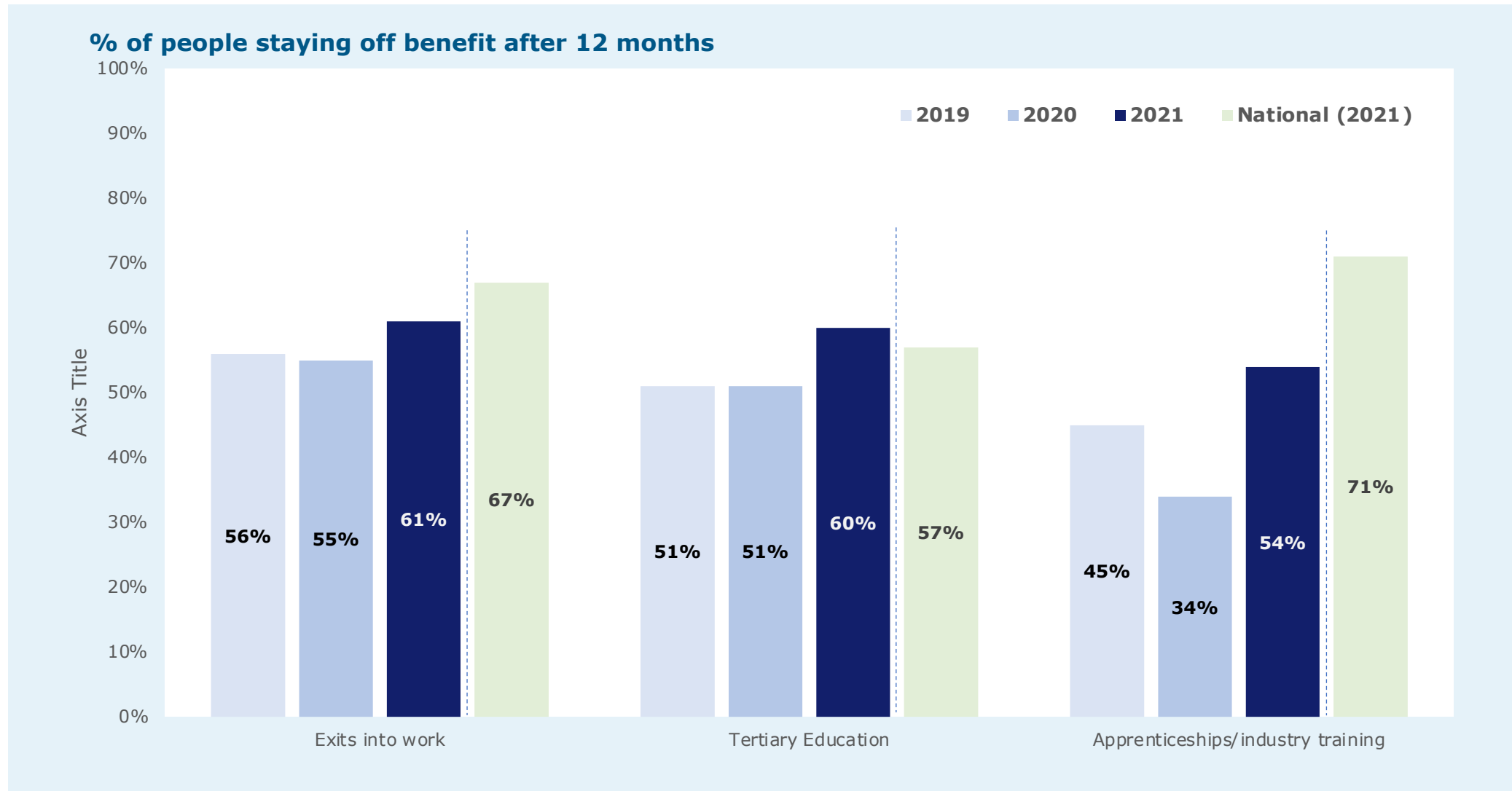
And young people need our support

estimated future years on main benefit

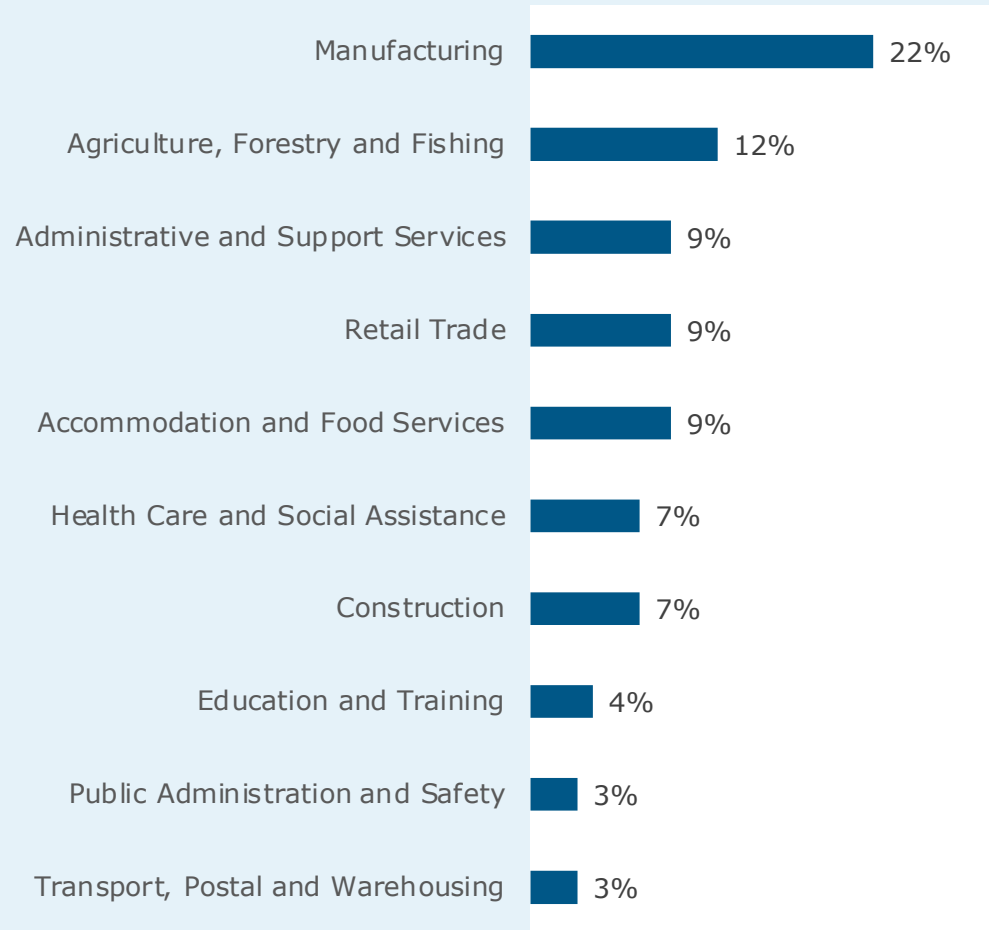


In Murihiku there are:

on a main benefit (18-24 years)

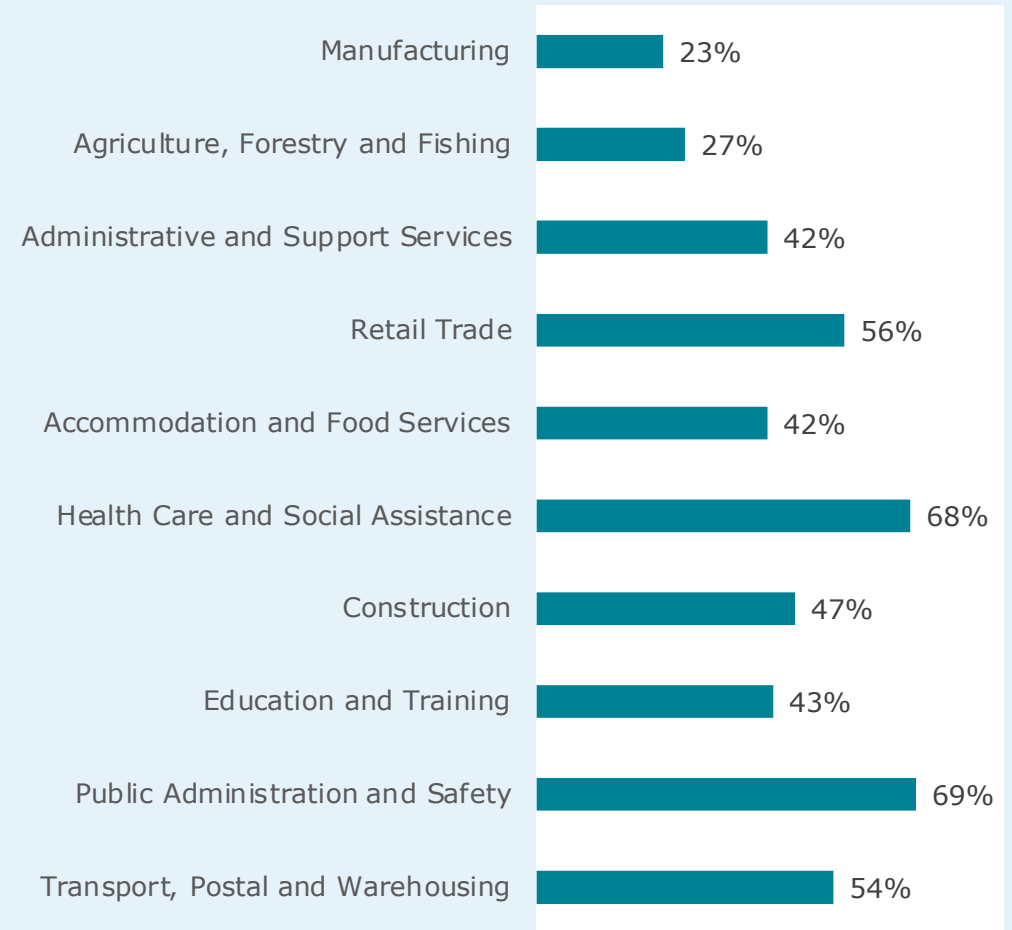
An increase in people remaining off benefit
